4.1 Strategic Plan Update – Director Lisa Walsh

Director Walsh explained a new plan is underway and expected to be launched for September. The new Strategic Plan is a four-year plan – from 2020 to 2024. The Plan will be presented to trustees at the May 26th board meeting for approval. Senior Administration sets the goals and reports the achievement to the board, outlining how the goals will be achieved, etc. Trustees define the 'what' and Director and Senior Staff and teams do the 'how'. The Plan is a multi-year plan as defined by the Ministry of Education, to promote student achievement and a positive school climate for all. The measurement of Strategic Plan is mapped out by the senior staff where annually we pick goals towards the 4 years and create the Director's Work Plan (DWP). The DWP concentrates on one year goals that we have aspired to achieve during one year and presentations are made to the board at their regular board meetings.

iAM Prepared focus is academic skills, literacy and numeracy in particular; digital skills, technology, and global skills. iAM Well focus is students feel valued, included, treated equity, and iAM Engaged gathers the students voice and choice.
